South Africa's fuel prices are adjusted on a monthly basis, informed by current international and local factors.

International factors include the fact that South Africa imports both crude oil and finished products at a price set at the international level, including importation costs, eg. shipping.

Rand/US Dollar exchange rate is a contributor to the cost of crude oil which is refined into petrol and petroleum products.

Current fuel price adjustments are due mainly to international factors - stronger Rand and lower crude oil prices.

- **Petrol (93 Octane, ULP and LRP): 184.00 c/l decrease;**
- **Petrol (95 Octane, ULP and LRP): 184.00 c/l decrease;**
- **Diesel (0.05% sulphur): 145.41 c/l decrease;**
- **Diesel (0.005% sulphur): 147.41 c/l decrease;**
- **Illuminating Paraffin (wholesale): 133.41 c/l decrease;**
- **SMNRP for IP: 178.00 c/l decrease;**
- **Maximum LPGas Retail Price: 243.00 c/kg decrease**
