- The Regional Directorate - Energy is established by the Controller to ensure effective and efficient application of the Petroleum Products Amendment Act No. 58 of 2003 and the Petroleum Charter, within the Region.

# What is a Controller

- A Controller is a person appointed by the Minister of the Department of Energy in terms of Section 3(1) of the Petroleum Products Amendment Act No.58 of 2003, as a controller of petroleum products within the Country.
- Petroleum products includes, paraffin, liquefied petroleum gas, bio-fuels, jet fuel, diesel, and petrol.

# Services Offered by the Office

- Our office will receive and process applications for retail, wholesale, or manufacturing of petroleum products and send them to Head Office for finalization.
- Conduct Compliance inspections on existing petroleum products outlets to ensure compliance to the PPAA.
- Hold awareness meetings with stakeholders on economic advancement opportunities available within the industry, with special focus to HDSA
- Render advisory services on petroleum licencing processes to facilitate the development of small business e.g. development business plan, licence application and tracing process

# Issues of Common Interest

- Applications for retail, wholesale, and manufacturing of petroleum products should be accompanied by a Record Of Decision from the municipal office on the Environmental Impact Assessment conducted on the proposed site.
- Applicants are required to submit an environmental management plan before a license can be issued on approved applications.
- Ensure compliance to environmental and petroleum products laws by operators.
